



Weather Satellite Launch Bingo

On June 25, 2024, a new weather satellite, called GOES-U, will be launching into orbit. (GOES is short for Geostationary Operational Environmental Satellite.) GOES-U is part of a group of NOAA (National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration) satellites that keep an eye on Earth's weather from space. It will also monitor space weather, which is activity in the sun's atmosphere.
